Darlington Rotary

Darlington Rotary has around 80 members who use their skills and experience to benefit the community, here and abroad.

It is part of Rotary North East, which comprises more than 50 clubs and groups and hundreds of members across the region.

We meet weekly in Darlington, usually on a Friday lunchtime, but the last Friday of the month is a breakfast meeting, popular with those who work.



Our activities

International Committee – supporting projects overseas
